

**Ethiopian Rural Household Survey
Community Questionnaire
Round 7**

Instructions to enumerators: The community survey is a very important component of the overall household survey. For this questionnaire, the community is defined as the peasant association (PA), but we want to know information about locally well-defined neighborhoods as well. Most of the information needed can be obtained from sources within the PA. Interview at least three people, perhaps together, who are knowledgeable about the community (e.g., community leaders, PA chairmen, elders, priests, teachers) including at least one woman. A few items, however, will need to be obtained from outside the PA. These are highlighted below. In general, when there is uncertainty regarding an answer, record the details in notes to the questionnaire.
